

Accessing Child Care Inspection Reports

Want to gather more information about a particular child care program?

Reading the program's inspection report can help you understand what regulations must be followed as well as how the program has followed those regulations.

Licensed programs are inspected at least once a year, when changes occur, or when there has been a complaint. Inspection reports reflect the rule compliance at a program on the day of the inspection. A licensing specialist visits the program, unannounced and inspects for a variety of items, such as: child/staff ratios, play equipment, child guidance, staff records, food preparation, and emergency protocol.

How to access Licensed Child Care Centers

In person/by phone: Programs are required to keep the most recent inspection report at the center, in an easily accessible area. If you are not able to locate it, please ask the center director. If you would like a program's inspection report mailed to you, you can contact Job and Family Services. (Follow the steps outlined under Family Child Care Providers)

Inspection type
 -Standard: a yearly inspection.
 -Complaint: a complaint has been filed with Job and Family Services and must be investigated

Compliance Status: A program is Fully Compliant by meeting all regulations or Partially Compliant if at least one (or more) areas are not meeting regulations.

As a result of any regulations not being met, the program must submit a corrective action, to show they have corrected the problem.


